we get to you in an emergency?

To reach you, your house or property numbers needs to be clearly visible from the road.

That means, your property number is large and well positioned so we can be see it during both day and night. It's also important that CFA fire fighters have room to safely bring their trucks into your property.

The average fire truck is 3m wide and 3.5m high – as such, driveways need enough clearance – 4.5m wide and 4m high so a large vehicle can drive through and members can easily access lockers.

Driveways also need to be clear of overhanging branches and structures like archways. In the event of an emergency, you may not be

If you have a fire at able to open locked or manual gates due to injury, illness or loss of power.

> Make sure gates to your property are in working order and can be opened fully.


