



Sadly local business, **B'zarte** ended with an auction of all remaining stock in the Jindivick Hall on 29 April.

History of the building Faye's grandparents, Bert & Mabel Pretty had the house/shop built in 1952, intending to move half the business from the general store across the road (to give them something to do in their retirement!) They stayed there until the late 70's. Following their deaths, Faye's mother, Lorna Parke, took over the Postmaster's role & operating the post office and milk bar until the end of the 80's. She then sold the business and building to Anne Bignell & Craig Browne. Anne's parents lived on site until the building was again sold, & ceased to be a Post Office. 

It's now the main time of year for fruiting bodies of some wonderful fungi to appear in Nangara reserve Fungi are not plants: they have their own kingdom & perform the essential role of decomposing dead plants &

animals, animal faeces, etc, back into the soil as nutrients for plants to use. Some fungi are animal food, & many insects use fungi as a larvae host. It's best not to disturb fungi as it's the fruiting body of a complex & extensive organism performing a vital role, contributing to the biodiversity of our native landscape.
